HOW IT WORKS To encourage the kids to get involved, we’re rewarding memorization success and other commendable Christ-like actions with award stickers each week.

Students can earn stickers the following ways:

- Memorizing one verse every week
- Memorizing the Big Idea Truth from the previous lesson
- Completing the Memorization Project: The Apostles’ Creed
- Attending and showing self-control each week
- Bringing a friend

THE GOAL Over the 13-week semester, we’ve challenged the students to earn 32 stickers.

WEEK 2 Jan. 17	<i>2 Corinthians 5:21 (ESV)</i> “For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.”	Jesus is completely human and completely God.	<i>Recommended: TBD</i>
WEEK 3 Jan. 24	<i>John 11:25 (ESV)</i> “Jesus said to her, ‘I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live.’”	Jesus died in our place, and His resurrection defeated death.	<i>Recommended: TBD</i>
WEEK 4 Jan. 31	<i>Ephesians 1:4 (ESV)</i> “He chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him.”	As God’s children, we are chosen and called.	<i>Recommended: TBD</i>
WEEK 5 Feb. 7	<i>1 John 3:1 (ESV)</i> “See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are.”	When a person believes in Jesus, they are “born again” and adopted into God’s family.	<i>The Apostles’ Creed</i>
WEEK 6 Feb. 14	<i>Proverbs 24:16a (ESV)</i> “...for the righteous falls seven times and rises again.”	God has set us apart, and is helping us grow a little at a time.	<i>The Apostles’ Creed</i>

WEEK 9 March 7	<i>1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (ESV)</i> “Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.”	The Church, God’s temple, is built with living stones.	<i>The Apostles’ Creed</i>
WEEK 10 March 14	<i>1 Corinthians 14:26 (ESV)</i> “When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.”	On Sundays, we gather for church to worship Jesus.	<i>The Apostles’ Creed</i>
WEEK 11 March 21	<i>2 Timothy 3:16 (ESV)</i> “All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness...”	God wrote the Bible through people, and His Word is true.	<i>The Apostles’ Creed</i>
