



Life Group Member Commitment

Commitment:

- I see commitment to the group as important (this will determine how much or how little we invest in the group).
- I commit to arrive on time and be faithful in attendance.
- I will contact the group if I cannot make it.
- I commit to use my gifts to serve the group. Areas of possible service may include:
 - leading group discussion guided by sermon questions (men only for mixed groups)
 - leading in singing (does not have to be weekly)
 - hosting group in your home or providing snacks -organizing hosting and snacks
 - collecting (and recording) prayer requests and distributing to the rest of the group
 - organizing events (bike rides, movie night, social events)
 - informing the group of special days like birthdays, anniversaries, births
 - organizing care – sickness, births, deaths in family
 - contacting assigned CCC missionary
 - organizing and encouraging outreach initiatives for group

Communication:

- Sharing should be personal, current, and focused – (not sharing for your spouse or others without approval) – move toward James 5:16 model
- Be willing to part of discussion while being careful not to dominate so others are excluded
- Any major decisions (new members; resignations; etc.) should be discussed as a group

Confidentiality:

- Personal gender-specific issues should be primarily with the same gender
- Keep conversations within group and don't share outside the group without permission
