

SERVING SURVEY

At many points in the New Testament, churches are described as “the body of Christ.” Each church is said to be made up of members who are given gifts by God, in order that those gifts might be used for the good of one another. And each church is given leaders, whose role (in part, at least) is to “equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ” (see Ephesians 4:11-13). Toward that end, our church leaders desire to equip CCC’ers by helping individuals find realms of service within the church and providing them with training and encouragement as they serve in those capacities.

Leadership Positions / Facilitators

- Serving as an elder/pastor
- Serving as a deacon
- Serving as a Life Group Leader
- Serving on the Women’s Ministries Leadership Team

Hospitality

- Greeting
- Serving at the Children’s Ministry Center Check-In
- Serving as a host for adult Life Education classes
- Serving as an usher (seating, take offering, etc.)
- Helping w/ coffee/drink preparation (classes, foyer, etc.)
- Hosting overnight guests in your home

Baptism and Communion Assistance

- Preparing bread and juice for communion
- Helping with baptism logistics (towels, filling baptistry, etc.)

Counseling

- Serving as a lay counselor within the church
- Serving as a mentor for (circle one):
 - Engaged couples
 - Younger adults
 - Potential missionaries

Care & Benevolence

- Visiting shut-ins or those in the hospital
- Assisting deacons in care for those in crisis
- Offering prayer support (praying for specific families/individuals)
- Assisting with needs among the CCC family (e.g. moving help, transportation etc.)

Meals & Food Provision

- Providing meals to individuals/families in need
- Organizing and providing snacks for church gatherings

Creative Arts

- Musicians (instruments or vocals)
- Graphic/visual design
- Photography (for events, communications, etc.)
- Videography (filming, editing, etc.)
- Sound Booth (projection, sound board)
- Décor (Christmas, Easter, Art Gala, etc.)

Finances

- Helping count offering
- Serving as a financial counselor
- Serving on the Finance Committee

Teaching

- Teaching adult classes/gatherings
- Teaching youth classes (7th-12th grade)
- Teaching children’s classes (2 year olds – 6th grade)

Grounds & Facilities

- Helping with periodic deep cleaning around the building
- Housekeeping for Children’s Ministries
- Helping with outdoor maintenance (weeding, trimming bushes, etc.)
- Shoveling snow

Events

- Set-up or tear-down (chairs, tables, clean up, etc.)
- Overseeing snacks/drinks
- Art Gala Team (in the spring each year)

International Mission Work

- Short-term mission teams
- Long-term international church-planting

Student Ministries

- Teaching
- Helping lead a small group
- Chaperoning special events (monthly or annually)
- Providing snacks

Children’s Ministries

- Sunday morning classes (teaching, or assisting): age level of interest: _____
- Lost & Found classes on Wednesday nights (station leader, greeting, teaching, set-up)
- Serving as a substitute (nursery – 6th grade)
- Leading games
- Special events (Vacation Bible School, parties, etc.)
