


When it comes to living God's Truth,

When it comes to living God's Truth, we believe it's best to know it by heart. That's why we're excited to help kids learn core doctrines of our Christian faith through catechism—using a collection of questions and answers designed for memorization and recitation. These biblical truths will be explored through the lessons from our curriculum: *The New City Catechism*.

Last year we studied Part 1 (Questions 1–20) of the catechism, which covered God, the Creation and the Fall, and the Law. This year we're studying Part 2 (Questions 21–35), which covers Christ, Redemption, and Grace.

HOW IT WORKS

To encourage the kids to get involved, we're rewarding memorization success and other commendable Christ-like actions with award stickers each week.

Students can earn stickers the following ways:

- Memorizing one verse every week
- Memorizing the catechism's Q&A from the previous lesson
- Completing the Special Memorization Project: Heroes of the Faith
- Attending and showing self-control each week
- Bringing a friend

THE GOAL

Over the next 12 weeks, we've challenged the students to work toward memorization goals based on their age (chart below!). At the end of the semester, we'll honor diligent students who've reached their goal with an award celebration and treats.
